





Sharm lies on the southern tip of the Sinai peninsular and has become a large cosmopolitan bustling and vibrant town, in huge contrast to the once fishing village of more than 10 years ago. It is now one of the world's most popular dive destinations with world class dive sites of Ras Mohammed and famous wrecks such as the SS Thistlegorm. Sharm now offers more than world class diving, it also caters very well for the seasoned holiday maker with its high number of hotels and resorts, restaurants, bars and night clubs. The mountainous desert landscape blends into a contrasting but strangely beautiful scenery and the waters edge is washed by the azure Red Sea.





The famous horseshoe shaped reef of Shaab El Erg is a perfect example of the reefs on offer on this cruise with its beautiful hard coral garden and the chance to see dolphins. Abu Nuhas has four well-known wrecks: Giannis D, Carnatic, the lentil wreck and the tile wreck, all offering spectacular dives and plenty of fish life.

Night dives can be superb in this area as Gubal Island offers protected anchoring for the night. A small wreck at 8-10 metres makes for a spectacular night dive with lionfish, scorpion fish and its resident giant moray eel.

A short ride across the straits of Gubal and you visit the most famous wreck of the Red Sea, the Thistlegorm! An awe-inspiring World War II British vessel with a cargo full of armaments (Bedford trucks and BSA motorbikes), which were all destined for the British troops in North Africa. She was sunk by the German Luftwaffe and now lies in 30 metres of water. Depending on divers' experience, weather and current

conditions, we also try to offer a night dive here. Close by is the Ras Mohamed National Park, offering a morning dive at the 'Shark Reef', a sheer wall falling into the blue. The Ras Mohamed Park is usually the 'border', from here the boat heads back towards Hurghada.

Dive the Best Top 3 sites in this area: Big and Little Brothers, Daedalus Reef and Elphinstone.

The Brother Islands are the pinnacles of two undersea mountains rising from the depths of the abyss and are located about 60 miles offshore. Part of the Marine Park Islands National Park, these islands offer stunning wall diving, with the walls being covered in soft corals and forests of gorgonians, creating a kaleidoscope of ever-changing colours. They attract a diverse array of marine species and large pelagics. Large tuna, Jacks and Snappers cruise in the blue, accompanied by occasional Hammerheads, Silvertips, Silky and Oceanic White Tip Sharks and Mantas. Even the rare Thresher Shark can be found here. Sightings of the Grey Reef Shark are almost guaranteed on the North and South Plateau of Small Brother.

For the wreck diver, the wrecks of the Aida II, an Egyptian supply vessel, and the Numidia, a cargo ship, lie on the walls of the Big Brother. Both are covered in a rich growth of soft and hard corals. Marine life includes a family of Napoleon Wrasse and Grey Reef Sharks.

Daedalus Reef, also part of the Marine Park, is a large, oval reef with a lighthouse and is the furthest offshore reef in the Egyptian Red Sea. Its deep walls and drop-offs offer some of the most spectacular diving to be found. Daedalus has mountainous, pristine, hard coral formations. There is also a strong chance of spotting schooling Hammerheads, and grey reef sharks.

Elphinstone, with its sheer walls covered in soft corals, offers a likely encounter with Oceanic White Tip sharks.

Note: 50 logged dives required by Egyptian Law

South & St. Johns (7 nights)

Sailing to the southern most reefs, these cruises depart from Marsa Ghalib to the vast reef system of Fury Shoals and St John's.

At Fury Shoals, dive Shaab Claude with its famous swim-throughs and huge porite corals. White Tip Reef sharks and an anemone and clownfish settlement can be seen a little off the reef to the South. Abu Galawa Soraya has a fantastic coral garden and a wreck of a private sailing boat packed with glass fish.

Dive Shab Sharm, with its wall dives and White Tip Reef sharks. Oceanic White Tips and Silky sharks can sometimes be found in the blue and turtles often visit the South side before heading further south to Wadi Gamal, with its flowing banks of hard yellow and green soft coral, resident angel and butterfly fish, and in the right season huge schools of placid jack and tuna visit the area.

St John's is a vast collection of small reefs offering some of the most remote and rewarding diving in the Red Sea. Habili Ali offers giant gorgonians and black corals whilst Grey Reef, Silvertip and schools of Hammerhead sharks might be found on the west side. Habili Gafaar is a mass of soft corals teeming with shoals of snappers, butterfly fish and barracudas. Mantas, Grey Reef and Silvertip sharks can be seen in the blue.

Gota Kebir is a massive reef, famous for its tunnels and south plateau, where jacks and barracudas can be seen and the occasional manta. The tunnels are ideal for novice cave divers.

Gota Soraya is rated as possibly one of the best wall dives in the Red Sea, with overhangs and cracks in the reef wall full of glass fish and sweepers and an abundance of corals, Grey Reef, Silvertips and Hammerhead sharks.





layang layang

This remote coral atoll is situated approximately 300 km off the coast of Sabah, approx one hour's flight from Kota Kinabalu. The atoll is 14 sq km in diameter and rises 2,000m from the ocean floor offering some spectacular wall diving. In 1985 the Malaysian Government reclaimed and created a 50 acre island on part of the reef, now known as Layang Layang Island. There are 14 main dive sites, all reached within 10-15 mins by boat from the resort. Average visibility is 50m. The reefs are largely unexplored with wonderful drop-offs, superb corals and prolific fish life. Layang Layang is famous for its Hamerheads which are commonly seen, with the best time of year being Mar-Jun. Other sharks normally encountered include leopard, black tip and white tip plus dolphins, giant mantas, barracuda and giant morays.



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Layang Layang Dive Centre

The in-house PADI dive centre is professionally-run by a team of six experienced and qualified instructors. Grenada is the most southerly of the Windward islands sitting north of Trinidad. Commonly known as the Spice Island, the capital St George has long been associated with nutmeg production. 

Only 27 miles long and 6 miles across at its widest point, allows easily exploration of the sites. The nutrient rich waters of the Orinoco River are carried past the island in what is the start of the Gulf Stream. While this can result in a dramatic drop in visibility it also means lots of manta rays and even whale sharks. The island offers diving for all levels of diver. The main dive sites are Speyside in the north-east and Crown Point at the south-west. The Caribbean's largest Brain Coral colony, measuring over 5m by 3m, is located nearby at Kelleston Drain. Due to the plankton enriched waters, there are frequent encounters with large Barracuda, Dolphin, Whale Sharks and Giant Sea Turtles. The wreck of the Maverick, a previous inter island ferry deliberately sunk in 1997, is sited along the north west coast. Other notable dive sites are the Tarpon Bowl and The Sisters which are huge rock towers that plunge to a depth from above the water to over 40m where Scalloped Hammerheads may be encountered. A memorable dive experience is to pass between these the rocks. Currents and surge can be a fast, so this is a good destination for the more experienced diver with fast drift dives with lots of big pelagics.

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Undersea Tobago

Based at Coco Reef Resort, this Professional PADI dive centre is owned and run by husband and wife team Derek & Evelyn Chung, who provide uncrowded diving and personal service. With over 20 years experience they not only bring safety, but a wealth of marine life and dive site knowledge with them on every dive. 800 miles to the east of Palau lies Truk lagoon encircling the islands of Chuuk. This is the location of hundreds of wrecked World War II Japanese & US boats and planes. The lagoon is sheltered allowing for calm diving conditions to leisurely explore the near intact cargo ships. The depth of wrecks varies from surface to around 35m with the famous Fujikawa Maru reaching to just over 30m. This wreck includes it original wings, wheels, guns, & artillery ammunition as well as the remains of those that perished. Japanese fighters sit close by 150m+ freighters including the 134m long Yamagiri Maru with huge gun shells. Tanks and trucks are still visible at the Nippo maru. Even submarines, such as the Heian Maur and the Gose Maru have periscopes, torpedoes & many artefacts still aboard. Well known wrecks to visit include: Rio de Janeiro maur at 104m and listing to her port side gives great views from above. The wrecks attract a wide range of fish feeding from the coral that has grown up over the years. Several nearby reefs offer alternative diving.

The area is famous for the inland lakes and a unique species of jellyfish that have developed in a predator free environment with no sting. The different variety of fish (over 1,500 species) feed on the nutrient rich ocean trenches to the east and west of the island chain. The soft coral and vast anemones cover the sheer walls in Palau. There are also barrier reef and blue hole diving. Liveboard diving is the best way to access the wide variety of dives and maximise your diving time. Any benefits derived from decreases in these costs will be passed on to you. In the case of any small variation, an amount equivalent to 2% of the price of your travel arrangements, which excludes insurance premiums and any amendment charges, will be absorbed or retained. For larger variations this 2% will still be absorbed for increases but not retained from refunds. No price increases will be made within 30 days of departure. If you have to pay an increase of more than 10% of the price of your travel arrangements, you may cancel your travel arrangements and receive a full refund of all monies paid, except for any amendment charges. We will consider an appropriate refund of insurance premiums paid if you can show that you are unable to transfer or reuse your policy. Should you decide to cancel for this reason, you must exercise your right to do so within 14 days from the issue date printed on your final invoice. Whether you cancel or not you will also be entitled, on the terms set out in respect of major changes in section 10, to accept an offer of alternative travel arrangements from us subject to availability and compensation if appropriate. Travel arrangements are not always purchased in local currency and some apparent changes have no impact on the price of your travel due to contractual and other protection in place. The UK government have announced their intention to replace Air Passenger Duty, which is payable by all passengers on flights departing from UK airports with a new Emissions Tax, known as Aviation Duty, with effect from 1st November 2009. At this time, we are not aware of the final details of the new Duty, and prices have therefore been calculated as if Air Passenger Duty continues to be in effect. In the event that our costs increase as a result of the change, we reserve the right to adjust the prices to reflect those changes in costs.

4. Insurance

YOU MUST NOT TRAVEL WITHOUT IT.

It is a fundamental term of this contract that you are required to have appropriate and adequate travel insurance for your chosen holiday. Please ask for details of the comprehensive policy we can offer. If you intend to dive, balloon, bungee jump, go jet boating or take part in any other dangerous pastime, make sure that you have the extra cover required. All policies must include medical treatment and repatriation in the event of an accident or serious illness. If you do not take out cover under our policy, you must advise us of the details of your own insurance including the name of the insurer and the policy number as soon as possible. Our representative abroad has the right to see the policy so that appropriate advice and assistance can be given. Clients in breach of this condition will be deemed to have indemnified the company for any consequential loss incurred by the company on their behalf and such costs will be redeemable from them.

5. Your Ticket Conditions

You accept when you travel with an air and/or a sea, train or bus carrier that their up to date approved Conditions of Travel apply, some of which may exclude or limit liability. These Conditions are often the subject of international agreements between countries, and copies of the Conditions which apply to your air, sea, train or bus travel are available on request

from us. When travel & health documents (passports, visas & inoculation certificates) are required for your holiday, it is your responsibility to procure them. We cannot be held liable in any way for any failure to do so,

6. If You Change Your Booking

If you want to change any details of your booking (e.g. transfer to a different holiday with us, departure date, airline, airport, change the number of people booked to travel, change or cancel an excursion or pre-departure special offer etc), we will do our best to help. If you or any member of your party are unable to proceed with the holiday, you can transfer the booking to a substitute person, providing they are suitable; satisfy all the conditions applicable to the original booking and are acceptable to us. Both the person taking and the person leaving the booking will be responsible for paying any additional costs arising from the transfer. We charge a minimum Amendment Fee of £45 per booking plus any non-refundable costs arising from the contract terms of our suppliers. However, if you change your booking within 56 days of departure, the cancellation charges will apply as shown below in addition to the above Amendment Fee. In the case of name changes, the applicable costs and/or cancellation charges will apply as appropriate. Important Note: Name changes and/or departure changes are not always permitted by airlines and most treat name changes as cancellations and charge accordingly. These charges will be passed on to you in addition to any other Amendment Fees. Once airline tickets have been issued any changes made to the ticket(s) may result in you having to pay for the cancelled ticket(s) and purchase a new ticket(s) at full cost. When the price is dependent on the number of people booked into the accommodation and it then varies because you wish to change that number of people, the price will be recosted based on the new party size. Any increase in price per person payable as a result of a part cancellation is not a Cancellation Charge. A separate Cancellation Charge will be levied in respect of bookings cancelled. A new confirmation invoice will be issued as appropriate, on which the Cancellation Charges will be shown.

7. If You Cancel Your Holiday

You or any member of your party may cancel your booking, or part of it, once it has been confirmed, but the instructions will only be valid if put in writing and signed by the person who made the booking i.e. the lead name on the booking. These written instructions should be sent immediately to us. To compensate us for the expense of processing your booking and for the risk that we may not be able to resell the holiday, we charge a cancellation fee on the scale shown below. The amount payable (by whoever confirmed the booking) depends on when we receive your written instructions - the more notice you give, the less we will charge. If you have to cancel for reasons covered by your insurance policy you should be able to recover your cancellation charges:

8. Changes By Us

There may be a change to flight timings or a hotel may close; a day-to-day tour, cruise or safari itinerary may change because of local circumstances altering the length of time spent in a town or lodge or even omitting a town or lodge due to local conditions. Cruise ships/boats may be changed without notice to ones with similar standards of facilities.

9. If We Change or Cancel Your Holiday

It is unlikely that we will have to make any changes to your holiday, but we do plan the arrangements many months in advance. Sometimes we may have to cancel your holiday or make changes, which we reserve the right to do at any time. Most of these changes are very minor, but where they are significant/major, we will inform you when you book, or, if you have already booked, as soon as it is reasonably possible if there is time before your departure. A major change is one that we make to your holiday arrangements before departure, including, but not exclusive to, changing your UK departure airport(s) (please note a change between the London airports of Gatwick, Heathrow, Stansted, London City and Luton is not classified as a 'major change'), resort area, scheduled time of departure or return by more than twelve hours, (except as detailed below, see important note*) offering accommodation of an officially lower category, or significantly increasing the price of your holiday. Any change in the airline or the type of aircraft from that stated in the brochure/website or on your ticket does not count as a Major Change. You then have the choice of either: A. accepting our offer of a replacement holiday of a lower category (if available). If the holiday is cheaper then we will refund the difference in cost to you, B. accepting our offer of a replacement holiday of equivalent or higher quality (if available) or, C. cancelling your holiday. If you choose A or B, the least compensation we will pay you is shown on the scale below. If you choose C, we will refund you all monies you have paid us plus at least the compensation shown on the scale below. Please note that it is advisable to leave booking domestic travel arrangements, hotel accommodation, and car parking etc until final travel documents are received.

* Important Note: Compensation payments do not apply to changes or cancellations caused by 3rd party resort developments, changes or

cancellations to schedules by airlines, the number of persons who have booked is less than that required for the package, or any "Force Majeure".

"Force Majeure" means unusual and unforeseeable circumstances beyond our control, the consequences of which could not have been avoided even if all due care had been exercised. Such circumstances or events include (but are not limited to) war or threat of war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, unavoidable technical problems with transport, closure or congestion of airports or ports, terrorist activity, natural

and nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions and health risks.

10. Tours

Some tours are dependent on minimum numbers. In the case of insufficient demand we reserve the right to consolidate or cancel the tour. In this case, we will offer the same tour on a different date or an alternative holiday or a full refund. We will not make any such changes within 10 weeks of departure. If you make additional arrangements that are not included on our confirmation invoice, we are unable to refund any costs incurred by you outside 10 weeks prior to departure. We reserve the right to vary tour accommodation, itineraries and programmes. Changes to that of a similar standard will not be considered a major change.

11. Our Responsibility For Your Holiday

We only accept responsibility for the proper performance of our obligations under this contract. We will perform such obligations with reasonable skill and care. We are not responsible for any failure that is:

- Attributable to you or a member of your party;
- Attributable to a third party unconnected with the provision of the services to you, and is unforeseeable or unavoidable;
- Attributable to our employees, agents, subcontractors and suppliers and their staff whilst acting outside the scope of their employment.
- Due to Force Majeure.
- Due to information, however obtained, from outside sources such as, independent third party websites.
- Any consequential loss not directly connected to the contract with us.

Personal Injury (unconnected with arrangements made by us). Although we cannot accept responsibility for clients who by misadventure suffer illness, personal injury or death during the period of their holiday arising out of an activity which does not form part of the foreign inclusive holiday or excursions booked through the company, general assistance will be afforded to clients to a maximum of £5,000 per booking. Furthermore, in the event either of there being a successful claim for costs against a third party or there being suitable insurance policy/ies in force, costs actually incurred by the tour operator shall be recoverable from the clients.

12. Limitations On Our Liability

Our liability to you for any loss or damage which you may suffer is limited to twice the price of your holiday. This excludes personal injury resulting from the non-performance or improper performance of the services involved in the holiday, and is subject to the limitation of liability described below. Health and safety standards applicable to the services provided by us under this contract should meet the local standards applicable to your holiday destination. However you should be aware that these vary widely across the programme and may well not match those standards we enjoy in the UK. Any compensation payable by us shall be limited in accordance with the lowest limit allowed under applicable International Conventions (Warsaw Convention 1929 as amended, Montreal Convention 1999 as amended, E.C. Reg No. 2027 - 1997, EC Reg No. 889 - 2002, EC Reg No. 261 - 2004, EC Reg 2111 - 2005 and EC Reg 1107 - 2006, Athens Convention 1974 (For Ships), Berne Convention (For Rail) and Paris Convention (For Accommodation) governing the services, or the amount you can recover from them under the laws of the UK or the country in which they operate. Transport operators have their own conditions of carriage, which form part of your contract with us. These conditions, and the provisions of the International Conventions, generally limit the liability of transport operators. Ask for Special Needs Form or if you develop a physical problem after booking, contact us as soon as possible.

13. Complaints

If you have a complaint you must tell our Service Representative, local agent, the accommodation management or the airline staff immediately. If we cannot resolve the problem at the resort or during your flight, you must write within 35 days of your return from holiday to us at Fleets Spatham Lane, Ditchling, East Sussex BN6 8XL or email us at info@sportif.travel. If you do not tell us about your complaint, our ability to investigate it could be seriously hampered, and we will not deal with it unless there is a valid reason why you didn't inform us. You can, of course, pursue your claim elsewhere. Disputes about your holiday that we cannot settle can be referred to arbitration under a special scheme administered by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. The scheme provides a simple and cheap method of arbitration based on documents alone. It does not apply to claims over £5,000 per person or £25,000 per booking form. A limit of £1,000 per person applies to any part of a claim for personal injury or illness. You must apply for arbitration within nine months of your return from holiday, but in special circumstances it may be offered outside this period. Information regarding complaints may be shared with other tour operators.

14. Disorderly Behaviour

We reserve the right to terminate without notice the holiday arrangements of any client whose behaviour is such that it is likely in our opinion to cause distress, damage, danger or annoyance to our customers, employees, agent's property or a third party. Furthermore, if you are prevented from travelling because, in the opinion of a person in authority, you appear to be unfit to travel or cause distress or discomfort to other passengers, then our responsibility for your holiday ceases. No refunds will be given. We have no control over the behaviour of other people staying in or visiting your holiday accommodation. Your accommodation is provided solely for the use of passengers shown on the final Confirmation Invoice as confirmed by us; subletting, sharing or assignment is prohibited. We expressly reserve the right to prevent you from participating in the excursions we provide, whether pre-booked or purchased in resort, if in the reasonable opinion of our staff or those of the excursion provider, you are either unsuited to undertake the excursion, or if you appear to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. In these circumstances your sole remedy against us will be to obtain a refund of the cost of that excursion.

15. Your Financial Security

The air holidays and flights in this brochure are protected by ATOL. When you buy an ATOL protected air holiday package or flight from us, you will receive a Confirmation Invoice from us confirming your arrangements and your protection under our Air Travel Organiser's Licence number 2910. In the unlikely event of our insolvency, the CAA will ensure that you are not stranded abroad and will refund any money you have paid to us for an advance booking. If you buy arrangements other than a package holiday this financial protection does not apply. For further information, visit the CAA website at www.atol.org.uk
